By excluding movement by mail, shipments would have to transit via ways that are likely to lead to reports to the Australian Border Force (ABF).</p>

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Chile	Medical Supplies (e.g. surgical and examination gloves, mask, etc.) and other Personal Protective Equipment.	<p>We are not aware of any regulation issued by the Chilean Customs Authority (Servicio Nacional de Aduanas - "SNA") or other Chilean authority that prohibits or restricts the export of these goods. Notwithstanding the above, SNA issued certain regulations to facilitate international trade during the emergency of Covid-19. These resolutions are summarized below:</p> <p>(a) Circular Letter No. 67, dated February 11, 2020: instructs the SNA's offices and administrators to apply sanctions and audit procedures only in certain specific cases during importation or exportation caused by the COVID-19, as assessed by the relevant SNA's officer;</p> <p>(b) Exempt Resolution No. 1179, dated March 18, 2020: provides 13 measures to strengthen international trade operations in Chile. Separately, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) has the following policies on exports of medical devices from embargoed countries:  <b>Cuba:</b> License applications for exports of medicines and medical devices subject to the EAR, whether sold or donated, are generally approved, subject to certain end use restrictions. 15 CFR §746.2(b)(1). <b>Iran:</b> OFAC's General License at 31 C.F.R. § 560.530(a)(3) authorizes the shipment of medicine and medical devices classified as EAR99. <b>Syria:</b> A license is not required to export or reexport to Syria medicine designated as EAR99. However, a license is required to export or reexport to Syria medicine on the Commerce Control List, such as certain vaccines and immunotoxins, and medical devices that are subject to the EAR. 15 CFR §746.9(c)(2). <b>Sudan:</b> Applications to export or reexport of medical items to Sudan will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Id. at §742.10(b)(3)(i)(C). <b>North Korea:</b> Applications to export medical devices that are determined by the U.S. Government not to be luxury goods are subject to a general policy of approval.
